


Native Elementor Form Support

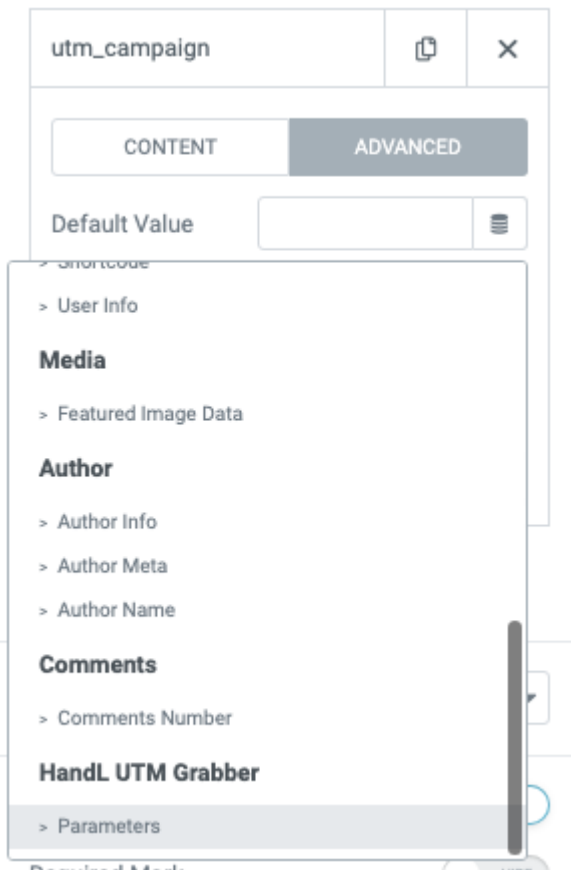
This is our preferred way of collecting UTMs into your Elementor Form.

First add your field just like any other field to your form

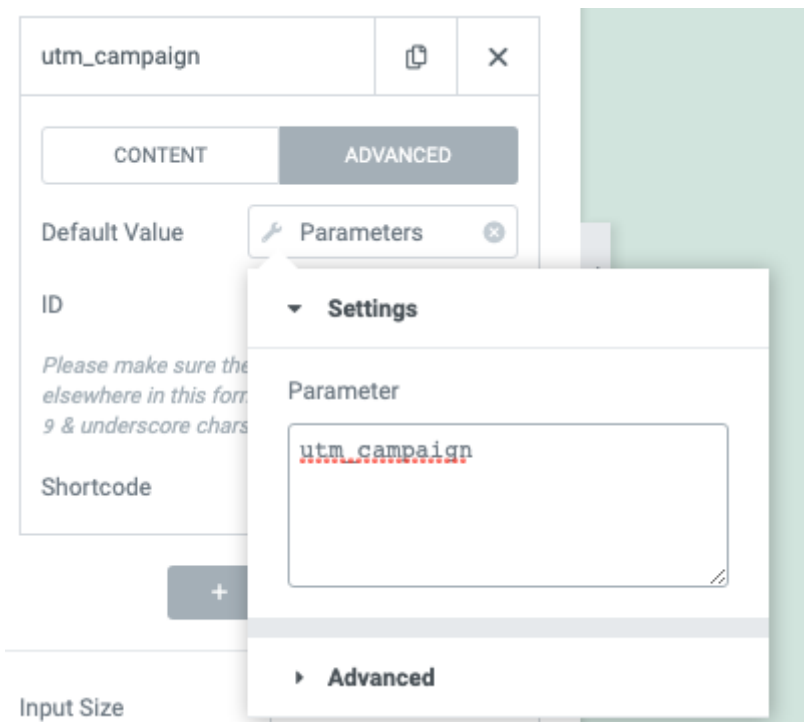
