


Contact Form 7 to Zapier Integration Screen Shot Documentation

1. Click Contact And Add New

Getting spammed? You have protection.

Spammers target everything; your contact forms aren't an exception. Before you get spammed, protect your contact forms with the powerful anti-spam features Contact Form 7 provides.

Contact Form 7 supports spam-filtering with [Akismet](#). Intelligent [reCAPTCHA](#) blocks annoying spambots. Plus, using [comment blacklist](#), you can block messages containing specified keywords or those sent from specified IP addresses.

Before you cry over spilt mail...

Contact Form 7 doesn't store submitted messages anywhere. Therefore, you may lose important messages forever if your mail server has issues or you make a mistake in mail configuration.

Install a message storage plugin before this happens to you. [Flamingo](#) saves all messages to the database. Flamingo is a free WordPress plugin created by the same author as Contact Form 7.
